- ❖ Archery Meeting: A meeting is scheduled for Jan. 28 at 7:00PM. Topics of discussion include our 3D shoots, our indoor shoots, and any other archery related topics of interest. Any and all suggestions are welcome.
- **❖ Indoor Archery Shoots:** Monday evenings beginning Jan. 7. Time: 6 to 10 PM. **COST**: adults \$3 per night. **Non-members welcome**.
- ❖ Wild Game Dinner: Saturday, Feb. 2 at the Sigel Sportsmens Club; serving starts at 6:00PM.
- ❖ State Wide "Wylie Coyotee" Hunt: Feb. 22, 23, and 24. Registration at the SCC Sat. Feb. 16 and & Sun. Feb. 17 from 1PM-4PM each day. Deadline for mail in registrations is Monday Feb. 11. A registration form is on the last page of this newsletter.
- ❖ .22 Rifle & Pistol Shoots: .22 rim-fire only! Start Tuesday Jan. 8 and end Tuesday Mar. 11. Time: 6 to 10 PM. Standard velocity ammo is recommended. Any safe .22 cal. rifle or pistol is permitted. All shooting is on paper targets and are provided by the club. The course of fire with either rifle or pistol is according to the shooter's interest. COST: adults \$3; juniors no charge if accompanying an adult shooter. Non-members welcome.
- ❖ Junior Rifle Program: The program will be conducted from 6 to 9 PM on Thursday evenings until Mar. 29. The focus of the program will be 4 position smallbore (.22LR) rifle competition. Beginner match rifles, shooting mats, targets, and required ear and eye protection are provided. Ammo is not provided, but standard velocity ammo is available for purchase. NOTE: The Sigel Rifle Team competes with several other smallbore teams in Venango, Clarion, Clearfield, and Indiana Counties; match schedules are posted at the club and on the club website. Juniors who have an interest and have the required skill level may join in the competition. COST: no cost other than ammo. - ❖ Rifle League Competition: The Sigel Rifle Team participates in 4 position smallbore (.22LR) rifle competition. Typical equipment includes Anschutz match rifles with high power scopes and heavy leather shooting jackets in addition to other equipment. Green Mountain League; Friday evenings from Jan. 4 to April 12. Tri County League; Wednesday evenings from Jan. 9 to Mar. 26. Banquets follow the last match in both leagues and trophies are awarded to the high scoring shooters by class. Club membership required to participate in league competition.
- ❖ Easter "Ham" Shoots: Thursday Mar. 13 & Thursday Mar. 20. This is a variation on the popular Easter Egg Shoot conducted by a couple of other clubs in the area. Course of fire is as follows: all shooters fire one shot on a paper target. All targets are then scored. The adult shooter firing the BEST CENTER SHOT wins a ham. The junior shooter firing the best center shot also wins a prize. This is repeated 11 more times. Essentially, there are 12 one shot matches with an adult and junior winner of each match. Each of the last 2 shots is called a **Losers Match**, which means, if you have won a ham during the first 10 you can not shoot in the last 2. These are fun and frustrating and require a little skill and a lot of luck! Cost: \$10 for adults; 16 yrs. and under \$5.
