- ❖ Annual Ground Hog Hunt: Runs June through September. A scale and sheet for recording names and weights are available at the club.

## **PAST EVENTS:**

- ❖ Plinker Shoots: Through out the season, which ran only for 8 weeks this year, there were from 10 to 20 shooters present working to improve their skills in the prone, sitting, kneeling, and offhand positions. All shooters, especially the juniors, showed considerable improvement. A nominal fee was charged each week and by the end of the season more than \$200 was added to the club treasury. For now, the season has ended but will resume in early January. Thanks to all who helped make this event a success.
- ❖ Indoor Archery Shoots: This was another event that was well attended. It also ran about 8 weeks. The indoor season has ended but will resume at a later date. Keep an eye on the website.
- **2**ND **Annual Wylie Coyote Hunt:** Feb. 17, 18, 19, 2006. This year about 400 hunters registered for the hunt and \$87 was paid out for each of the 25 **coyotes** bagged.
- **Easter "Ham" Shoots:** Another event that proved to be worth the effort. Two shoots produced \$165 profit for the club. During the 2 shoots, more than 2 dozen hams were won by the adults and the juniors took home a lot of Easter candy.
